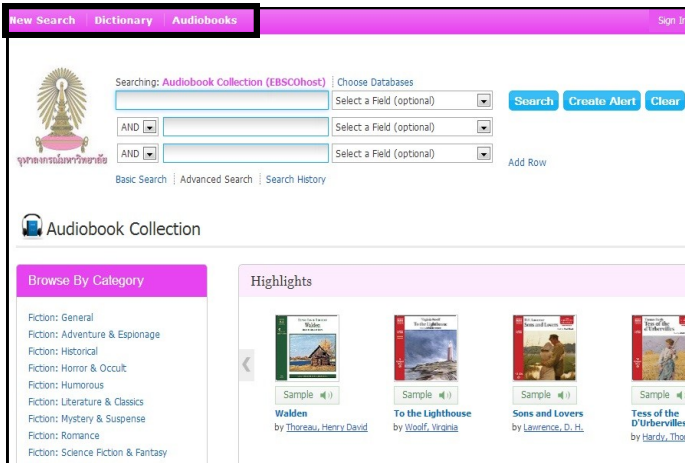
EBSCO Audiobook Collection is the fiction books database covering various genre such as General, Adventure & Espionage, Historical, Horror & Occult, Humorous, Literature & Classics, Mystery & Suspense, Romance and Science Fiction & Fantasy, which are available in audio format. The database provides a Download Manager software that needs to be installed in user's device in purpose to play a downloaded Audiobook.

How to begin

Go to <http://www.car.chula.ac.th/curef-db/slist.html#general> and select [EBSCOhost Web](#). The screen will be shown EBSCOhost's gateway as the following picture.



Click at [Audiobook Collection](#) to access the database. Then the homepage will be shown as picture below.



New Search, Audiobooks, and Dictionary are provided by the database at the top menu, to help users found what you want from Audiobook Collection.

New Search

The first menu is *Searching* with search panel.

➊ **Advanced Search** panel is available for searching on the upper side of homepage. Users can perform **many search terms** in **specific field**, and then select related condition [**AND, OR, NOT**] to search Audiobook.

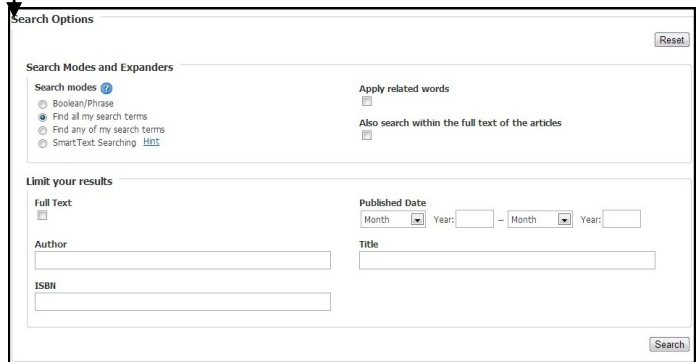
Click **Add Row** for adding more search terms box.

➋ **Basic Search** panel will be appeared when users click at the option: **Basic Search**, below search panel. It allows users search with **word or phrase** filled in the box and click **Search** as the next picture.



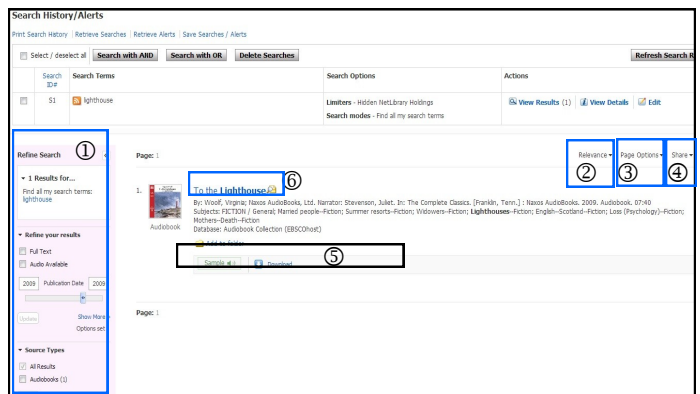

➌ **Search Options** is a supporter to set **Search Modes and Expanders** and **Limit your results**, when users use **Advanced/Basic Search**. Click at the arrow to turn on **Search Options**.



➍ **Search History** will be saved automatically while searching. Users can check it anytime.

➎ **Search Results** will be displayed **Audiobooks' title list** and functions that users can work on as following:



➏ **Refine Search** by **Full Text / Audio Available, Publication Date, and Source Types**

➐ **Sort Results** by **Relevance, Date, Source, Author, Title, Date Added**

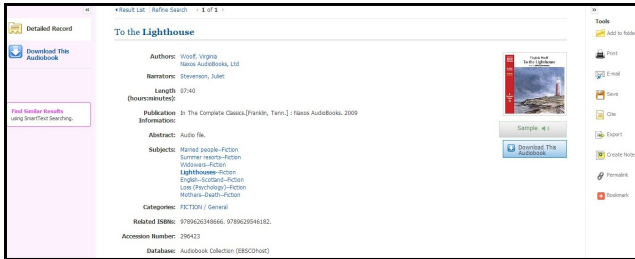
➑ **Set results format and layout** from **Page Options**

➒ **Share results** via **permalink, Add to folder, and create alert.**

➓ Listen a **Sample** or **Download**

Users have to log in the database and install software ‘Download Manager’ before downloading Audiobook. If not, the system will ask you to install the software automatically.

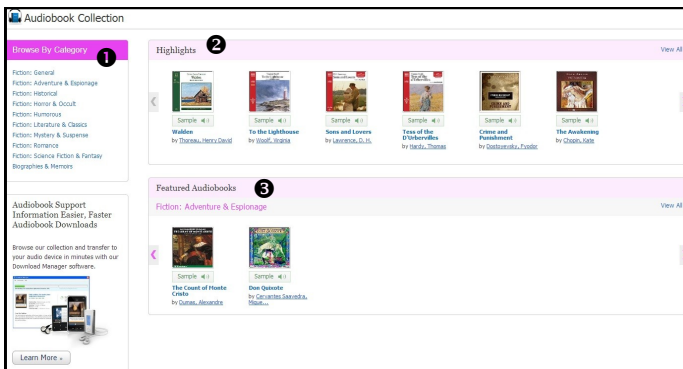
⑥ **View more detail** about each item by clicking at the **title**. And users can see **Tools** here.



Audiobooks

Underneath this menu, users can *browse* Audiobooks by many ways as the following:

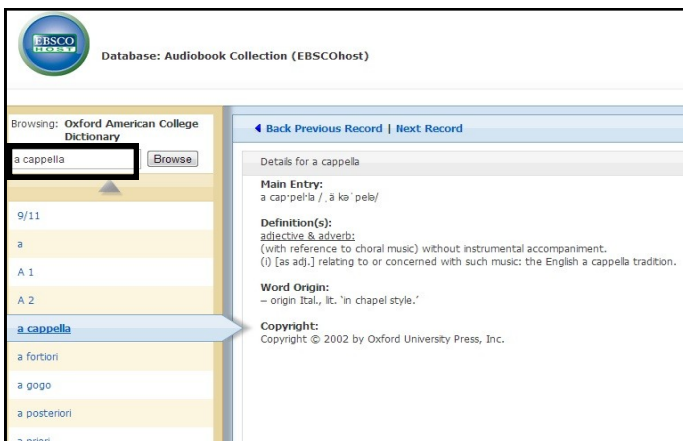
- 1 Browse By Categories** - Users can select a **category (genre)** in focus to view all of its collection.
- 2 Highlights** - Using the left and right arrows, or click **View All** to view a list of all Highlights Audiobooks.
- 3 Featured Audiobooks** - The Latest Added Audiobooks in each category is displayed here. Users can use the left and right arrows, or click **View All** to view a list of all Featured Audiobooks.



Results from browsing will be displayed same as Search Results.

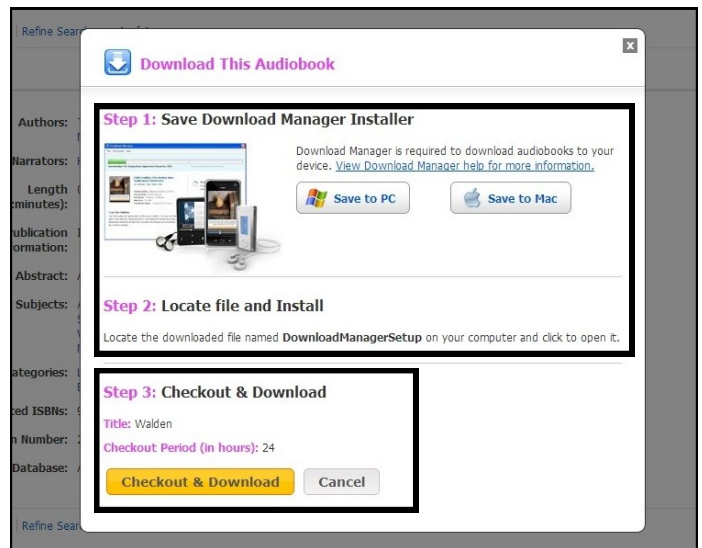
Dictionary

The database provides an *Oxford American College Dictionary* for searching definition of any terms. Users can type **word or phrase** in the box and click **browse**. As this picture is shown the definition of ‘acappella’.



How to Download Audiobooks

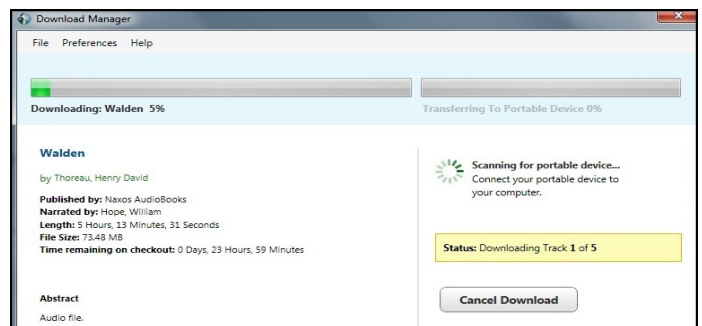
When users click **Download this Audiobook**, you will see new window like this picture.



Step 1-2 : For users who don't have Download Manager software, select **Save to PC/Mac** and follow the process of installation.

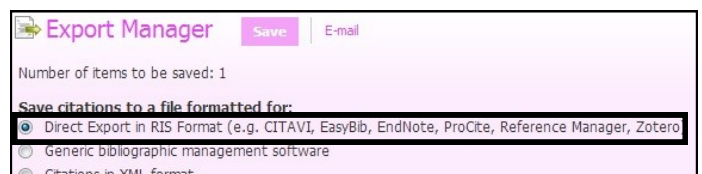
Step 3 : For users who have the software already, Click at **Checkout & Download**. The software will operate downloading of your selected Audiobook, and then transfer it to **Apple Devices [via iTunes]** or **Windows Media Player**, depended on user's choice.

This picture below shows **Download & Transfer status**.



Export Citation

Users can click **Export** at Tools (in Audiobook's detail), to open **Export Manager**. Then choose option available for you such as **Direct Export in RIS Format** (in case you want to export to EndNote), and click **Save**.
